An authentic 1941 Silk City Diner, George & Sally's Blue Moon Diner is a piece of historic roadside Americana. For nearly 60 years and countless cups of coffee, this eatery was a landmark in Meriden, CT serving locals and weary travelers alike.

Silk City Diners was a division of the Paterson Wagon Company, later known as Paterson Vehicle Company, based in Paterson, NJ. They produced approximately 1,500 diners from 1926 until 1966. This particular diner seats 36 and features an exterior of porcelain enamel panels with an interior of blue tiles, stainless steel star bursts, and chrome counter stools.

It originally opened as "Joe's Diner" on Center Street in Meriden, CT in 1941. After many years of operation, Joe turned the diner over to his daughter, Gina, who renamed it Gina's Diner, and then later the Blue Moon Diner. In 1997,

the popular eatery officially closed its doors in Meriden and the building remained empty for several years.

Thanks to a financial gift made in memory of local residents George and Sally Turner by their family, the museum pursued the roadside diner.

In 2003, the Blue Moon Diner was purchased by the Gilmore Car Museum and the building traveled nearly 800 miles to Hickory Corners, MI. After stopping in Cleveland, OH where it underwent a partial restoration, it arrived on

the museum's campus to great fanfare on June 3, 2004.

More than a simple exhibit, George and Sally's Blue Moon Diner has become a slice of living history and is open for lunch and sweet treats each day, serving signature Gilmore hot dogs, smooth frozen custard, locally made pies, and other typical diner fare to over 125,000 museum visitors every year!
